## HIGHLIGHTS

### Regulatory Changes

- Release No. 221 includes regulatory changes published in the Federal Register as of March 6, 2013.

### Provisional Unlawful Presence Waivers of Inadmissibility for Certain Immediate Relatives

- Release No. 221 incorporates into the text the amendments made by the DHS final rule on provisional unlawful presence waiver, which was published on January 3, 2013, 78 FR 536, effective March 4, 2013. The final rule amends DHS regulations to allow certain immediate relatives of U.S. citizens who are physically present in the United States to request provisional unlawful presence waivers prior to departing from the United States for consular processing of their immigrant visa applications. The new provisional unlawful presence waiver process is embodied in a newly added 8 CFR § 212.7(e). In addition, the final rule amends 8 CFR § 212.7(a)(1), (a)(3), and (a)(4), as well as fee-

related provisions at 8 CFR § 103.7(b)(1)(i)(AA) and (c)(3)(i), to coordinate those provisions with the new waiver process. With the amendments now incorporated into the text, the Editor's Note at the beginning of 8 CFR § 212.7, which had set forth the amendments in the form of an informational notice prior to their effective date, is now removed.

## ALSO INCLUDED IN THIS RELEASE

### DHS Regulations (8 CFR), Vol. 1

**CFR Corrections.** On December 28, at 77 FR 76532–76533, DHS published three *CFR Corrections* to Title 8 of the Code of Federal Regulations, revised as of January 1, 2012, viz., to 8 CFR §§ 208.24, 209.2, and 214.2. These were corrections of errors occurring in the official print edition revised as of January 1, 2012. The errors *did not* occur in the text of Bender's Immigration Regulations Service. To insure completeness of the section histories, the section histories of 8 CFR §§ 208.24, 209.2, and 214.2 have been updated to reflect the

Federal Register citations for the CFR Corrections, with notations indicating that the corrections relate to the print edition of the CFR revised as of January 1, 2012, and that the errors did not occur in the text of sections as set forth in Bender's Immigration Regulations Service.

**Update to the Class B Port of Entry Description; Opening of Boquillas Border Crossing.** The text of 8 CFR 104.4(a) has been updated to reflect revision of the sentence describing "Class B Port of Entry". The text has also been updated to reflect opening of the Boquillas, Texas, Border Crossing as a Class B port by inserting a "Class B" subheading, together with reference to the new port, under "District No. 14—El Paso, Texas". These revisions were directed by U.S. Customs and Border Protection final rule, 77 FR 76352, December 28, 2012, effective January 28, 2013.

**Closing of Port of Whitetail, Montana.** The text of 8 CFR § 100.4(a) has been updated to reflect closing of the Port of Whitetail, Montana, by removing reference to that port from the list of Class A ports of entry under "District No. 30—Helena, Montana". This change was directed by U.S. Customs and Border Protection final rule, 77 FR 75823, December 26, 2012, effective January 25, 2013.

**DHHS Regulations (42 CFR), Vol. 2 Annual Update of HHS Poverty Guidelines.** The annual update for the year 2013 by Department of Health and Human Services of its Poverty Guidelines is included in this release for insertion into Volume 2 at the end of the material behind the DHHS Regulations tab. The annual update was published in the Federal Register on January 14, 2013, at 78 FR 5182.
