HIGHLIGHTS

All of the chapters have been updated, except Chapter 28. Dozens of important new cases relating to D&O liability, litigation, indemnification and insurance are discussed.

Chapter 2. Chapter 2 updates include an analysis of recent cases addressing whether the business judgment rule applies to claims by the FDIC against directors and officers of failed banks.

Chapter 6. Chapter 6 updates include a discussion of recent regulatory developments relating to director and officer responsibilities in connection with cyberrelated risks.

Chapter 8. Chapter 8 updates include recent developments involving the growing number of criminal proceedings against directors and officers for violation of the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act.

Chapter 9. Chapter 9 updates include an analysis of the landmark new *Fifth Third Bancorp* U.S. Supreme Court decision

which, among other things, eliminated a presumption of prudence regarding plan fiduciaries' investment in company stock.

Chapter 11. Chapter 11 updates include an analysis of recent case law addressing various defenses asserted by directors and officers of failed banks in the growing number of claims against them by the FDIC.

Chapter 12. Chapter 12 updates include a discussion of the important new Delaware "public benefit" corporation statute.

Chapter 13. Chapter 13 updates include:

- A discussion of the U.S. Supreme Court's recent decision in *Halli-burton II*, which confirmed that a plaintiff is entitled to a rebuttable presumption of reliance in securities class action lawsuit;
- A discussion of case law developments since the U.S. Supreme Court's 2007 decision in *Tellabs v. Makor Rights & Issues, Ltd.* regarding scienter;
- A new section summarizing the

- U.S. Supreme Court's three recent decisions regarding federal securities fraud class action jurisprudence: *Halliburton I* (2011); *Amgen* (2013); and *Halliburton II* (2014); and
- A discussion of recent cases construing the whistleblower provisions of the Sarbanes-Oxley Act and the Dodd-Frank Act.

Chapter 14. Chapter 14 updates include a discussion of recent Delaware case law describing the responsibility of directors in various types of acquisition transactions, including where a controlling shareholder buys the interests of minority shareholders.

Chapter 15. Chapter 15 updates include a discussion of recent developments relating to state law claims by a corporation against its directors and officers for illegal insider trading (i.e., *Brophy* claims).

Chapter 18. Chapter 18 updates include a new section which discusses the validity and impact on D&O claims of litigation forum selection clauses in bylaws.

Chapter 20. Chapter 20 updates include

a new section which discusses statutes and case law defining the scope of indemnification for LLC managers.

Chapter 21. Chapter 21 updates include a discussion of how an allocation provision in a D&O insurance policy may impact the applicability of the insured v. insured exclusion in the policy.

Chapter 26. Chapter 26 updates include a discussion of issues relevant to an excess insurer's claim against a primary insurer for wrongful claims handling.

Chapter 27. Chapter 27 updates include a discussion of the impact of new Side A DIC provisions in ABC policies.

Chapter 29. Chapter 29 updates include summaries of recent studies and surveys relating to D&O litigation and insurance trends.

Appendix A is updated to include a list of the most recent mega D&O settlements.

Appendix D is updated to include an example of the most recent broad-form Side A policy form.
