

## Juris<sup>®</sup> for Microsoft<sup>®</sup> Outlook<sup>®</sup> Release Notes

Juris<sup>®</sup> 2.6 is the first version to include the Juris<sup>®</sup> for Microsoft<sup>®</sup> Outlook<sup>®</sup> add-in. Features include:

- View information about your Juris clients and matters from within the Outlook software.
- Quickly access clients and matters related to the email or calendar item currently selected in your Outlook software.
- Enter billable time directly from your Outlook software.

### Installation notes

Before installing the Juris for Microsoft Outlook add-in, do the following:

- Ensure that you have a supported version of Microsoft Outlook (Outlook 2007, Outlook 2010, or Outlook 2013).
- Ensure that your Juris server and the ports used by Juris are correctly set up. Additionally, if the SMGR user account is still using its default password, you cannot log in to Juris for Microsoft Outlook as SMGR until the password is changed.
- Ensure that Juris Suite is installed on the computer where you will install Juris for Microsoft Outlook.
- Locate the file `JMOSetup.exe` and ensure that it can be run from the computer where you want to install Juris for Microsoft Outlook.
- Close Microsoft Outlook on your computer.

While installing the server component of Juris for Microsoft Outlook, if the Juris server name automatically detects an IP address, you must click the 'Change' button and enter the server name instead. Juris for Microsoft Outlook does not recognize an IP address as a valid Juris server name.

### Important Note for Time Matters<sup>®</sup> Customers

Do not install the Juris for Microsoft Outlook add-in on a computer where Time Matters<sup>®</sup> for Microsoft Outlook add-in is already installed, or vice versa. LexisNexis does not currently support configurations in which both Outlook add-ins are installed simultaneously. In order to use the Juris add-in, you must first completely remove the Time Matters add-in.

## Plans for the future

The following issue will be considered for inclusion in a future release.

- Time Matters *for* Microsoft Outlook may become inoperable after Juris *for* Microsoft Outlook is installed on the same computer.
